



Materials: Pevensey Bracelet Tutorial By Michelle Snyder

- Superduo Beads
- 3mm Firepolish Beads
- 3mm Round Beads or Pearls
- Size 11 Seed Beads (SB11)
- Size 15 Seed Beads (SB15)
- Clasp
- 2 – Jump Rings
- 6lb Fireline beading thread
- Size 11 Tulip needle

*The number of beads needed will depend on the length of your bracelet. My bracelet uses (148) Superduos, (136) 3mm Firepolish beads, and (29) 3mm Round beads. My bracelet has 9 units and is 6 inches before the clasp.



Materials: Olivia - cones with rivoli 12mm - pendant

- Rivoli 12mm
- cylinder beads Miyuki Delica 11° - colors for the mint green version:
 - o A - nickel - DB0021 - 1 g
 - o B - light mint - DB1526 - 1 g
 - o C - mint - DB0374 - 1 g
 - o D - dark mint - DB0373 - 2 g
- 15° round seed beads - nickel color (Miyuki SB0190) - 0,5 g
- 7pcs of 8x6 (or 7x5) olive beads or 5mm (or even 6mm) round beads or other similar beads of your choice
- thread (e.g. Nymo B, S-lon or similar)
- 1 crimp bead • jump ring • bail

Materials: Diamond Back Bracelet

- 2g size 11° seed beads
- 4g size 10° cylinder beads
- 10g (20 pcs) Navette beads
- 2 size 5mm jump rings, 18ga
- toggle or clasp of choice
- D weight beading thread
- 2 size 10 or 12 beading needles
- Scissors or thread cutters
- two pairs of pliers



Materials: Hidden Gem Earrings

- 2g 15o seed beads
- 1g 11o seed beads
- 1g 8o seed beads
- 1g 11o Delicas
- 2 size 12mm Rivolis
- 16 GemDuos
- 32 SuperDuos
- Size 10/12 beading needle
- D weight thread/6lb. Fireline to match
- Pair of ear wires/ear posts
- Scissors
